January 2, 2008

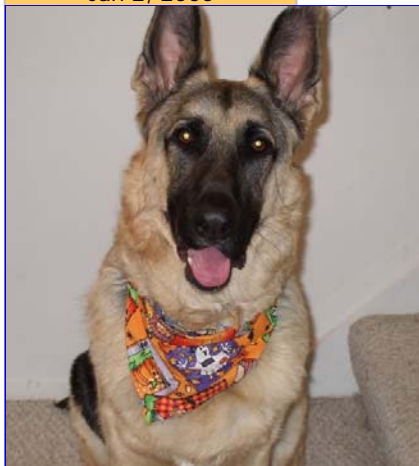
